

## LEGISLATIVE BILL 264

Approved by the Governor March 8, 1991

Introduced by Schrock, 39; Elmer, 38; Beutler, 28; R.

AN ACT relating to natural resources districts; to amend section 2-3218, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to change provisions relating to per diem payments for district board members; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 2-3218, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

2-3218. Board members shall be compensated for their actual and necessary expenses incurred in connection with their duties. Each board is hereby given the power and authority to may provide a per diem payment for directors of not to exceed fifteen fifty dollars for each day that such director attends meetings of the board or is engaged in matters concerning the district, but no director shall receive more than one two thousand dollars in any one year. Such per diem payments shall be in addition to and separate from compensation for expenses.

Sec. 2. That original section 2-3218, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
