AN ACT relating to aeronautics; to amend section 3-407, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to change height requirements for marking and lighting structures as prescribed; to repeal the original section; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 3-407, Reissue Revised Statutes of

Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

3-407. All structures outside the corporate limits of cities and villages, exceeding a height of one two hundred fifty feet above the surface of the ground, and all structures within the corporate limits of cities and villages exceeding a height of five hundred feet shall be marked and lighted in accordance with rules and regulations established by the Department of Aeronautics. The department is authorized to adopt and establish promulgate rules and regulations for the marking and lighting of such structures in a manner calculated to prevent collisions therewith with such structures by aircraft. It shall be the duty of the persons, firms, and corporations owning, maintaining, or using such structures to provide and maintain such marking and lighting.

Sec. 2. That original section 3-407, Reissue Revised

Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.

Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act shall be in full force and take effect, from and after its passage and approval, according to law.
