

LEGISLATIVE BILL 112

Approved by the Governor April 12, 1995

Introduced by Hillman, 48; Robak, 22; Bernard-Stevens, 42

AN ACT relating to state highways; to amend section 39-207, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change provisions relating to rural highway signs; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 39-207, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:

39-207. Tourist-oriented directional sign panels shall be erected and maintained by or at the direction of the Department of Roads within the right-of-way of rural highways as described in sections 39-2102 and 39-2103 which are part of the state highway system, except on freeways as defined in section 39-1302 such as the National System of Interstate and Defense Highways and interchanges on expressways as defined in section 39-1302; to provide tourist-oriented information to the traveling public in accordance with sections 39-207 to 39-211.

For purposes of such sections:

(1) Rural highways means (a) all public highways and roads outside the limits of an incorporated municipality exclusive of freeways and interchanges on expressways and (b) all public highways and roads within incorporated municipalities having a population of forty thousand people or less exclusive of freeways and interchanges on expressways. Expressway, freeway, and interchange are used in this subdivision as they are defined in section 39-1302; and

(2) Sign panel means 7 sign panel shall mean one or more individual signs mounted as an assembly on the same supports.

Sec. 2. Original section 39-207, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.
