LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 26CA

PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

Passed by the Legislature April 16, 1997

Introduced by Withem, 14; Kristensen, 37; Warner, 25

THE MEMBERS OF THE NINETY-FIFTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, FIRST SESSION, RESOLVE THAT:

Section 1. At a special election on May 12, 1998, the following proposed amendment to the Constitution of Nebraska shall be submitted to the electors of the State of Nebraska for approval or rejection:

To amend Article I, section 20: I-20 "No person shall be imprisoned for debt in any civil action on

mesne or final process, 7 unless in cases of freud."

Sec. 2. The proposed amendment shall be submitted to the electors in the manner prescribed by the Constitution of Nebraska, Article XVI, section 1, with the following ballot language:

"A constitutional amendment to eliminate an exception to the

prohibition on imprisonment for debt.
