

LEGISLATIVE BILL 522

Approved by the Governor April 28, 1999

Introduced by Suttle, 10

AN ACT relating to juveniles; to amend section 43-411, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change provisions relating to detainers for apprehension and detention; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 43-411, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:

43-411. The Director of Health and Human Services shall have the authority, and may delegate the authority only to the Administrator of the Office of Juvenile Services and the superintendents of the youth rehabilitation and treatment centers, to issue detainers for the apprehension and detention of juveniles who have absconded from a placement with or commitment to the office. Any peace officer who detains a juvenile on such a detainer shall hold the juvenile in an appropriate facility or program for juveniles until the office can take custody of the juvenile.

Sec. 2. Original section 43-411, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.
