AN ACT relating to courts; to amend section 24-201.01, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2000; to change judges' salaries; to repeal the original section; and to declare an emergency.
Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 24-201.01, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2000, is amended to read:

24-201.01. On July 1, 1998, the salary of the Chief Justice and the judges of the Supreme Court shall be one hundred one thousand six hundred forty-nine dollars. On July 1, 1999, the salary of the Chief Justice and judges of the Supreme Court shall be one hundred six thousand two hundred twenty three dollars. On July 1, 2000, the salary of the Chief Justice and judges of the Supreme Court shall be one hundred eleven thousand three dollars. On July 1, 2001, the salary of the Chief Justice and the judges of the Supreme Court shall be one hundred eleven thousand three dollars. On July 1, 2001, the salary of the Chief Justice and the judges of the Supreme Court shall be one hundred fourteen thousand three hundred fifty-eight dollars. On July 1, 2002, the salary of the Chief Justice and judges of the Supreme Court shall be one hundred nineteen thousand two hundred seventy-six dollars.

The Chief Justice and the judges of the Supreme Court shall hold no other public office of profit or trust during their terms of office nor accept any public appointment or employment under the authority of the government of the United States for which they receive compensation for their services. Such salaries shall be payable in equal monthly installments.

Sec. 2. Original section 24-201.01, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2000, is repealed.

Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when passed and approved according to law.
