LB627 creates the Free Student Meals Act & eliminate provisions relating to reimbursement for school breakfast programs.

The Nebraska Department of Education (NDE) will create & administer a grant program to reimburse a qualified school for a portion of the cost of each breakfast & each lunch served by the school during the second preceding school year in an amount intended to offset the cost of providing breakfasts & lunches at no cost to all students. NDE will make disbursements annually to each school that applies for the grant & complies with the requirements of the Free Student Meals Act in the amount of:

- For each qualified school that has adopted the community eligibility provision for the school year that such breakfasts & lunches were served:
  - The difference between the federal reimbursement rate for a free breakfast & the federal reimbursement rate for fully paid breakfast for each fully paid breakfast served
  - The difference between the federal reimbursement rate for a free lunch & the federal reimbursement rate for a fully paid lunch for each fully paid lunch served
- For each qualified school that has not adopted the community eligibility provision in the year that the breakfasts & lunches were served:
  - o Thirty cents for each eligible breakfast served to a student eligible for a reduced-price breakfast
  - o Forty cents for each eligible lunch served to a student eligible for a reduced-price lunch
  - The difference between the federal reimbursement rate for a free breakfast & the federal reimbursement rate for a fully paid breakfast for each fully paid breakfast served
  - The difference between the federal reimbursement rate for a free lunch & the federal reimbursement rate for a fully paid lunch for each fully paid lunch served

## **EXPENDITURES:**

LB627 states the intent to appropriate money from the General Fund to carry out the provisions of the bill but does not clarify the amount to be appropriated.

NDE estimates the need for \$40,000 of Federal Funds to update their current claim processing system to include the state reimbursement.

Based off of the 2018-19 public school meal counts, NDE estimates that reimbursements for breakfast will be \$5.835.897 & reimbursements for lunches will be \$49,343,624. Non-public schools & all CEP eligible schools are not included in this estimate.
