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# DISTRICTS at-A-GLANCE 

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This first edition of Districts At-a-Glance ranks Nebraska legislative districts in a variety of metrics - from economics to health to education. While past publications in our "At-a-Glance" series focused on state-by-state comparisons and county-level analysis, Districts At-a-Glance focuses exclusively on ranking legislative districts. It is a statistical snapshot of Nebraska, designed to give policymakers and the public a glimpse of the challenges and opportunities facing different districts across the state. All of the data in this report comes from the Census Bureau's American Community Survey (ACS), which was conducted over five years, from 2010 to 2014. The ACS represents the gold standard in domestic demographic and statistical data.

## METHODOLOGY



The tables, graphs, and maps in Districts-at-a-Glance use the most current data available for all 49 Legislative Districts. Districts are always ranked from highest to lowest value, without regard to subject matter, so a higher ranking is not always preferable to a lower ranking.

The rankings in this report were determined using multiple decimal places of precision. However, for the purposes of the tables on each page, values are rounded to a single decimal place. Thus, two disticts can appear equal in their numerical measure, but still have different rankings.

Every ranking also includes a colorcoded map and a bar graph comparing the highest and lowest ranked districts. Source information is located at the bottom of each page, including a link to the raw data. Text in each header includes supplemental information about the subject, including definitions, additional rankings, and more detailed data.
